Year 7 Textbooks	Extra information
<b>Art and Design</b> SJC Visual Art Diary	Compulsory item. To be distributed in class.
<b>Chinese</b> Learn Chinese Learn Culture Book 1 (Zhang)	This book must be purchased through Campion. It cannot be purchased second hand as it contains workbook exercises.
<b>English</b> Collins Australian Compact Dictionary 7E (H/B)  Detention (P/B) [Bancks] Black Cockatoo (P/B) [Merrison and Hustler]	This is the recommended dictionary and it is retained until Year 12. Other editions can be used. A comparable dictionary is acceptable. <i>Detention</i> and <i>Black Cockatoo</i> are the Year 7 novels. Second hand copies are acceptable.
<b>Health and Physical Education</b> Nelson VIC Fit for Life! HPE 7 & 8 Student Book (2 Yr Access Code)	This book is not available second hand as it was a new edition in 2021 and it is retained for Year 8. Do not access the digital component. This will be done in class.
<b>Humanities</b> Oxford Big Ideas VIC Humanities print and digital	This is a printed textbook (with an access code on the inside cover for an etextbook). This is a new edition for 2022 and cannot be purchased second hand. Do not access the digital component. This will be done in class.
<b>Italian</b> Italian Workbook to be purchased from Campion	This is a new edition for 2022 and must be purchased through Campion. It is retained for Year 8.
<b>Mathematics</b> Cambridge VIC Essential Maths 7 Print and Digital 2 <sup>nd</sup> Edn  Calculator Casio Scientific FX-82AU Plus II	This is a print and digital text. If the textbook is purchase second hand the activation code for the digital resource must be valid. Textbook codes can be checked for validation at <a href="https://www.cambridge.edu.au/codecheck/">https://www.cambridge.edu.au/codecheck/</a> If the code is not valid in the second hand text a reactivation code must be purchased.  This is the recommended calculator that will be used for Year 7-9. If students are continuing with Maths in the VCE a new calculator will need to be purchased in Year 10.
<b>Music</b> Musicianship & Aural Training Level 1 Student Book (2 <sup>nd</sup> Edn) [Smith]  Earphones stereo ultra lightweight with adapter	This is a hard copy book. It must be purchased new as it is a workbook.  This is a compulsory second set of earphones that will be kept in the music room for the semester.
<b>Religious Education</b> Bible NRSV Catholic Edition  St Joseph's College Geelong Journal	This Bible is retained until Year 12.  This is a journal for students that will be used throughout their time at SJC.
<b>Stationery Items</b>	All of the stationery items on the booklist are necessary, but it is possible to purchase them elsewhere.
